

# God is Great

## Psalm 145

**Today we are exploring how great God is and how we can tell others about how great God is.**

### What You Need

Worship – worship music, cardboard, scissors, tape or stapler

Bible Story and Activation – paper and pens, Psalm 145

### Worship

Give the children a piece of card, decorate it with “God is great!” and stickers, drawings etc. Roll the card into a cone shape and secure with staples or tape.

Sing a song about God’s greatness, using your megaphone to declare God’s greatness. You could use “Our God is a Great Big God” - <https://www.youtube.com/watch?v=eaXPXWBcE3I>

### Bible Story

Together, create a poster which shows everyone who God is, include the amazing things God has done, what he is like, the names which describe God.

Explain: There are lots of songs called Psalms about God in the Bible. They were written to help us understand more about God.

Read Psalm 145 and decide together what reasons it gives for praising God and why He is great. How many reasons can you find?

Use the megaphones to proclaim each reason loudly, declare - God is great! after each reason. (eg: God is king of the world because He made it – God is great!)

Look at verse 3 together: “The Lord is great and deserves all our praise! No one can fully understand his greatness!”

Talk about ways you can praise God for who he is and how great he is.

Recognise we can't fully understand his greatness but that God loves to give us pictures to help us understand things. Ask God to show each of you in a picture what His greatness looks like. Share the pictures God gives you with each other.

## Activation

God doesn't want us to keep it to ourselves, he wants us to tell other people about how great God is.

What would you tell your friends and family about how great God is?

Find a way to make it happen: write a card to grandparents, skype some friends, put a poster up in your window.
